

**MINUTES

Item #1 Mayor Pro Tem, BJ Bjornberg, called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Item #2 Invocation was given by Alderman Damon Johnson.

Item #3 The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Item #4 Officials present: Mayor Pro Tem BJ Bjornberg, Aldermen Jeff Solinsky, Leonard Johnson, Damon Johnson, Town Clerk Melissa Davis and Chief of Police Delbert Keel.

Absent was: Mayor Donna Duvall and Alderman Ray Blanchard.

Item #5 Alderman Damon Johnson made a motion to accept the minutes from the April 18, 2023 regular meeting as presented. Seconded by Alderman Jeff Solinsky. All I's.

Item #6 Alderman Damon Johnson made a motion to accept the financial reports ending April 30, 2023 as presented. Seconded by Alderman Leonard Johnson. All I's.

Item #7 A motion was made by Alderman Damon Johnson that was seconded by Alderman Jeff Solinsky to adopt Resolution #9 of 2023 (Vernon Parish Police Jury Resolution for the month of June 2023) with the addition of requesting the police jury side arm mow the road going to the Rosepine Historical Society Park. All I's.

Item #8 A discussion was held concerning the signs that would display the state championship for the Rosepine High School baseball team. The public works director stated that he was waiting on three different people to call him back but he needed to know the specifications of they sign before he could get prices. It was decided for the public works director to go view the sign Pitkin has displayed for their baseball championship and try to find out who put the sign up.

Item #9 Alderman Jeff Solinsky made a motion to present Ordinance #1 of 2023 (2023 – 2024 Budgets). Seconded by Alderman Damon Johnson. All I's.

Item #10 A discussion was held concerning how to determine the easement that is currently in place on Main Street. The public works director stated he would get with the police jury to see if they have any documents that would state what the easement would be on Main Street. Alderman Damon Johnson made a motion to hold the public hearing for the reconstruction of Main Street at the next regular meeting on June 20, 2023. Seconded by Alderman Leonard Johnson. All I's.
