

**MINUTES  
TOWN OF ROSEPINE  
REGULAR MEETING HELD AT TOWN HALL

**JULY 21, 2026– 12:00 PM**

Item #1 Mayor Donna Duvall called the meeting to order.

Item #2 Invocation was given by Alderman Solinsky.

Item #3 The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Item #4 Officials present were Mayor Donna Duvall, Aldermen BJ Bjornberg, Damon Johnson, Jeff Solinsky, Town Clerk Melissa Numbers, and Chief of Police Delbert Keel.

Absent: Alderwomen Jessica Shell and Leonard Johnson.

Item #5 Alderman Damon Johnson made a motion, and Alderman Solinsky seconded to accept the minutes as presented from the June 23, 2026, regular rescheduled meeting. All I's.

Item #6 Mayor Duvall welcomed attendees and shared information about upcoming town events. She acknowledged the new businesses that have recently opened and, alongside Chief Keel, provided a brief overview of the FLOCK cameras, noting that Sheriff Craft would issue a statement on their use.

During Mayor's Comments, Mayor Duvall asked the public works director to give an update on the reopening of Oak Street. He explained what he learned from the survey.

Alderman Solinsky made a motion to add "Oak Street" to the agenda as Item #8. Seconded by Alderman Damon Johnson. All I's.

Item #7 Chief Keel informed the board that he had spoken with Mr. Brister, who said he would no longer park his loaded truck by the high school.

Item #8 A discussion was held with several options being mentioned concerning a solution to the elementary school pickup line. Alderman Solinsky made a motion, seconded by Alderman Damon Johnson, to authorize the public works director to contact the town attorney and request that he send a letter to the property owners requesting permission to reopen Oak Street, and meanwhile, they requested the public works director, along with the chief of police, look for an alternative route for the elementary school pickup line. All I's.

Item #9 A motion was made by Alderman Damon Johnson and seconded by Alderman Bjornberg to accept the financial reports ending June 30, 2026, as presented. All I's.

Item #10 A motion was made by Alderman Solinsky, seconded by Alderman Damon Johnson, to adopt Resolution #12 of 2026 (Vernon Parish Police Jury Resolution for August 2026). All I's.

Item #11 Mayor Duvall opened a public hearing concerning the adoption of Ordinance #4 of 2026 (An Ordinance Amending Appendix B - Utility Fees Schedule of the Town of Rosepine's Code of Ordinances). A brief discussion was held, and Mayor Duvall closed the public hearing.

Item #12 Alderman Solinsky made a motion to adopt Ordinance #4 of 2026. Seconded by Alderman Bjornberg. All I's by roll call vote.

Item #13 A brief discussion was held concerning the annual utility rate review. No action was taken.

Item #14 With no further business, Alderman Solinsky motioned to adjourn. No objections.
